October is going to be a busy month for the Lowcountry Emmaus Community!
Please mark your calendar with the following dates; we look forward to seeing you.

Friday, October 15 @ 7:30 pm Gathering at Pinopolis UMC 1833 Pinopolis Road, Pinopolis SC 29469 (843) 761-8477

Directions: from Charleston: Take the Moncks Corner/Goose Creek exit off of I26 and head up Hwy 52. Stay on 52 until you pass the welcome sign in Moncks Corner. Turn Left at the first light onto "old" Hwy 52. At the second stop light take another left onto Hwy 6 (Main St.). Pass Berkeley High School and bear right at the fork. This will bring you into Pinopolis. The church will be on the left.

From Columbia: Take the Pinopolis exit off of I26 and go left. Cross Hwy 176 and Hwy 6. You will enter Pinopolis and the church will be on the left.

Directions to Jericho UMC for Send-Off and Closing: Take I26 to Exit 149 (Hwy 33N) towards Cameron. Go to the stop sign at the gas station, turn right onto Hwy 176 and go 2.5 miles past the Flea Bite Creek Bridge. Turn left; the church is approximately 1.6 miles on the right.

Directions to Providence Church for Candlelight: Take I26 to I95. Turn north onto I95 (stay south if coming from the Sumter area). Got to exit for Hwy 176 at mile marker 90. Turn west toward Cameron. Providence Church is approximately two miles on the right.


