Dr Arnetta Beverly, a gifted storyteller and humorist, graduated from Dunbar High School in Lexington, NC. She received her Associate in Arts Degree from Davidson County Community College, her Bachelor of Arts Degree from Shaw University in Raleigh, NC, her Master of Divinity Degree from Duke University, and her Doctor of Ministry degree from Drew University. From 1986-1992, she served as pastor of Chestnut Grove and Piney Grove United Methodist Churches. In 1987, she was elected to the Lexington, NC City Council. She was re-elected in 1989 and served until she resigned to serve St. John UMC in Eden, NC and Chapel Hill UMC in Reidsville, NC. From 1998-2001, she served as the Director of Nurturing and Ethnic Ministries in the Western NC Conference of the United Methodist Church. In July 2001, she was appointed to the Cabinet and served as the Northeast District Superintendent until 2007. In 2007, she became the Director of Connectional Ministries in the Western NC Conference and the Southeast Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church. Since July 2008, she has served as pastor of St. Matthews UMC in Greensboro, NC. Dr. Beverly is the mother of two sons and has eight grandchildren. She makes her home in Greensboro, NC
